



"There is no single distinctive doctrine which makes men Baptists. It is their position on a number of beliefs, which when taken together, make them a distinctive people."







New Testament Churches have a Single, Simple Message of Salvation



Matthew 16:18; Mark 3 – Luke 6; 1 Corinthians 12:28





"Since the Supper is an ordinance of the church, it must inevitably follow that whatever would debar a man from the church must also debar him from the Lord's table in that church.







That the local church is the custodian of this ordinance, and must judge the qualifications of those desiring to partake of it, is shown by the fact that the command to observe it was given, not to individuals, but to a company (Luke 22:29, 30). Manifestly, this table is inside and not outside the church.
