Day 1

Genesis 8:1-14; Psalm 51:10-12

Micah 7:8; Philippians 4:13; Psalm 23:4

The negative words you've spoken must be replaced with faith filled declarations. Take a moment to reflect on your recent words. Are they life giving or limiting? Ask God to help you reframe them with His truth, transforming doubt into confidence, aligning your words with divine purpose and empowering His work in your life. What will you declare today?

Acts 2:1-4; Joel 2:28-29
