SERMON NOTES AND SCRIPTURE

Mark 10:17–18 (NIV)

17 “As Jesus started on his way, a man ran up to and fell on his knees before him. “Good teacher,” he asked him, “what must I do to inherit eternal life?” “Why do you call me good?” Jesus answered. “No one is good – except for God alone. You know the commandments: ‘You shall not murder, you shall not commit adultery, you shall not steal, you shall not give false testimony, you shall not defraud, honor your father and mother.’”

Mark 10:21–22 (NIV)

Mark 10:26 (NIV)
