

The Engine Underneath **Discussion Questions**

1. Where do you see the culture defining virtues like love, knowledge, or self-control differently than Christ does? How does that show up in your own life?
2. The sermon described corruption as slow decay — something that looks healthy on the surface while quietly weakening underneath. Where do you sense that kind of slow thinning in your own spiritual life right now?
3. Peter says everything needed for life and godliness has already been given through Christ. What is the difference between producing spiritual growth and participating in it? What does that feel like practically?
4. Warm community without deep formation is community on borrowed time. What does tending the engine actually look like for you personally in an ordinary week?
5. If you were honest about what is currently forming you — what is actually shaping your desires and decisions — what would you name? Is that what you want forming you?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
