Rolling Away the Stones Discussion Questions

1.	Where in your life have you quietly decided, "Even Jesus can't do anything here"? What might it look like to invite Him into that place?
2.	How is obedience the bridge between belief and seeing God's glory in your own life? Can you think of a time when stepping out in obedience opened the way for God to move?
3.	How does fear show up in your life, sometimes disguised as "being wise" or "being realistic"? What would it look like to surrender that fear to Christ?
4.	Where are you tempted to choose what is convenient or "safe" rather than what is faithful? How might Jesus be calling you to deeper conviction instead of compromise?
5.	How does remembering that our life came through Jesus' surrender reshape the way you view your own "stones"? What step of surrender might Jesus be inviting you to take today?
	These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
