

***Drawing Near to the Holy King: Immanence and
Transcendence in God's Presence***
Discussion Questions

1. How does understanding God as both immanent (close) and transcendent (holy and set apart) change the way you approach Him in prayer or worship?

2. In what ways do we sometimes treat our relationship with God too casually? How can we develop a deeper sense of reverence in our daily walk with Him?

3. Reflecting on Exodus 19, what stands out to you about the way the Israelites were called to prepare themselves before encountering God's presence? How can we apply that idea of preparation in our own spiritual lives?

4. The sermon mentioned the need for a mediator between us and a holy God. How does the role of Jesus as our mediator impact your understanding of grace and forgiveness?

5. How does the concept of God's transcendence challenge or encourage you when facing difficulties or uncertainties in life? How can recognizing both His closeness and His majesty help you in those moments?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
