

Restless **Discussion Questions**

1. Augustine said, “Our hearts are restless until they rest in You.” Where do you most often look for rest, identity, or fulfillment outside of Christ?

2. The crowd in Acts 2 was “cut to the heart.” What is the difference between simply agreeing with truth intellectually and being personally convicted by it?

3. The sermon described repentance as “a direction you turn” rather than merely behavior management. How does that reshape the way you think about following Jesus?

4. Following Jesus often costs something relationally, socially, or personally. Have you ever experienced tension, loss, or discomfort because of your faith? What helped you continue forward?

5. Acts 2 shows the Holy Spirit forming people into a community, not just changing individuals privately. What does it practically look like for Christians to “make room” for people who are coming through the turn right now?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
