

The Heart of the House: Who We Are and How We Live

Discussion Questions

1. Identity Before Activity: Peter tells the church, “You are...” before saying anything about what they should do. How does knowing who you are in Christ shape the way you live, serve, or make decisions?
2. Belonging and Weakness: The sermon shared how the church created space for weakness and dependence. Why do you think belonging often grows deeper when people are honest about their limits?
3. Mission Filter: CrossPoint’s mission is *welcoming everyone into a transforming relationship with Christ*. How might this mission shape the way you welcome people—both inside and outside the church?
4. Values in Action: Which of the five core values (People & Community Matter, Rooted in Christ & Scripture, Servant Stewardship, Spirit-Dependent & Prayerful, Missional Living) do you see most clearly lived out at CrossPoint? Which one do you sense God inviting you to grow in?
5. Living Like You Belong: The call was to “live in every room like you belong here.” What would it look like for you to live that out this week—in your relationships, workplace, or neighborhood?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
