

Where We Begin: Believing in God

Discussion Questions

1. Which part of the opening line of the Creed—Father, Almighty, or Creator—felt most meaningful to you? Which felt most difficult? Why?
2. How have your life experiences shaped the way you think about God as “Father”? What might it look like to let Jesus reshape that understanding?
3. The sermon suggested that God’s power is often shown through presence, not prevention. How does that challenge or encourage the way you think about suffering and faith?
4. What changes when we believe our lives are created with purpose rather than accidental or self-made? How does that affect the way we live day to day?
5. The Creed begins with trust, not certainty. Where in your life right now do you sense God inviting you to trust Him more deeply?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
