

You Already Have It **Discussion Questions**

1. Where do you feel the pressure to find the “next level” or something that finally makes your faith click? What do you think is driving that?

2. In Acts 2, the crowd is amazed by the experience—but Peter redirects them to Jesus. Why do you think it’s so easy to focus on the moment instead of the message?

3. The sermon emphasizes that the Gospel is not a starting point, but the main thing. How have you personally treated the Gospel—as foundational, or something you’ve moved past?

4. Which part of the Gospel feels hardest for you to live from right now—Jesus lived, Jesus died, Jesus was raised, or Jesus reigns—and why?

5. Who in your life might be quietly asking, “What does this mean?” right now? What would it look like for you to share the Gospel with them in a simple, clear way this week?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
