

The Language of Home **Discussion Questions**

1. What does “the language of home” mean to you personally? When have you felt truly seen or understood?
2. In Acts 2, people heard the message of God in their own language. What does that reveal about God’s heart toward people?
3. Where in your life do you feel the need to have it all figured out before you act? How does this passage challenge that?
4. Is there someone in your life who feels “different” or hard to connect with? What might it look like to move toward them instead of pulling back?
5. Where might God be inviting you to step out this week—even if you feel unprepared? What would it look like to trust Him in that space?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
