

***From Doubt to Worship: An Encounter with the Risen Jesus***  
**Discussion Questions**

1. What's a label—spoken or unspoken—that you've carried, and how has it shaped the way you see yourself or your relationship with God?
2. Thomas wasn't the only one who needed to "see" before believing (John 20). Why do you think we often single him out? What does that reveal about how we judge others?
3. The sermon describes waiting as something that can shift from "delay" to "absence." Have you experienced that in your faith? What did it do in you?
4. Jesus meets Thomas *before* calling him to believe. Why is that order important? How does that reshape the way you think about faith and doubt?
5. Where might you be setting conditions with God right now (even quietly)? What would it look like to move toward trust instead of waiting for everything to be resolved?

*These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.*
