Discussion Questions

1. When you hear Jesus say, “The hour has come,” what emotions or images come to mind? How does this moment shift your understanding of His mission?
2. Jesus redefines glory through the image of a seed dying to bear fruit. Where might God be inviting you to trust Him in a season of “burial,” believing new life will come?
3. What does surrender look like in your daily life right now? What’s one area where obedience might feel costly but could lead to deeper faith?
4. Jesus’ soul was “troubled,” yet He chose to say, “Father, glorify Your name.” What helps you move toward obedience even when you feel afraid or uncertain?
5. Jesus said, “Walk while you have the light.” What step of faith do you sense God calling you to take while His light is still shining on your path?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
