The God of the Fourth Day Discussion Questions

1.	Have you ever experienced what Pastor Michael called a "fourth-day moment"—a situation that felt completely hopeless? How did you respond?
2.	Martha processed her grief with questions; Mary processed with tears. Which do you most relate to, and how has Jesus met you there?
3.	Jesus declared, "I am the resurrection and the life" in the present tense. What does it mean for resurrection power to be available "right now" in your life?
4.	The crowd whispered distorted views of God: love without power or power without love. Which distortion do you sometimes struggle with, and how does Jesus correct it?
5.	What would it look like for you to move from faithful hopelessness to confident trust in Jesus today?
	These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
