

## ***More Than Coins*** **Discussion Questions**

1. Where in your own life have you quietly lowered the ask — not dramatically but gradually — because hope felt too risky?
  
2. The sermon distinguished between survival and restoration, maintenance and transformation. Where have you settled for something that maintained your situation rather than changed it?
  
3. The restoration in this story was rooted not in anyone's faith but in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. What changes about hope when its ground is outside you rather than inside you?
  
4. Hope is not ultimately hope in an outcome — it is hope in a person. Where have you been hoping in an outcome, and what would it look like to reorient that toward a person?
  
5. Luke ends the story not with the man walking but with the man inside the temple. The miracle was the means. The entrance was the point. What gate have you been sitting outside of — and what would it mean to walk through it?

*These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.*
