Discussion Questions

1. Before this message, what did communion primarily mean to you? What part of today's teaching expanded or challenged your understanding?

2. The sermon described communion as reminding us of **what Christ has done, what he is doing now, and what is still to come**. Which of those three truths do you most need to hold onto in this season, and why?

3. The New Testament describes communion as *koinonia*—participation in the life of Christ and fellowship with his people. How should that reality change the way we think about our relationships within the church?

4. We heard that "repetition isn't the danger; coming without paying attention is." What are some practical ways you can come to the Lord's Table with greater intentionality instead of simply going through the motions?

5. CrossPoint will begin receiving communion every week. How do you hope this regular rhythm will shape your own walk with Christ, your love for the church, and your hope for the day when Christ gathers his people at the marriage supper of the Lamb?

These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
