The Father Who Runs Discussion Questions

1.	Where do you see yourself in the story Jesus told—more like the younger son, the older brother, or somewhere in between? Why?
2.	The younger son doubted his father's heart before he ever left. Have you ever felt that God was holding out on you during a season of waiting? How did that affect your trust?
3.	The older brother stayed close but didn't feel celebrated. In what ways might we be "serving" God but still missing the joy of being His children?
4.	How does it change your view of God to imagine Him running toward you—not just once, but again and again?
5.	What would it look like for you to 'come home' to the Father this week—whether for the first time, or just more fully than before?
	These questions should spark deeper reflection and meaningful conversation about the key points of the sermon.
