REKINDLING AN EVANGELISTIC FLAME

Paul reminds Timothy to "rekindle the gift" in him. The term "rekindle" refers to a fire. A fire is something that must be tended, or it will go out. Paul is challenging Timothy and all believers to keep the fires of the gospel blazing. Living the gospel and sharing the gospel are how you keep this fire blazing. Fear or a timid nature could stop any of us from sharing the gospel. How can you get past a timid nature?

Pray for opportunity and courage to share the gospel, and then just do it. We were saved because the Son of God displayed courage and left heaven to die upon the cross for lost humanity. Timothy's mother and grandmother courageously lived and shared the gospel with Timothy. Timothy was challenged to rekindle this fire in himself by courageously living and sharing the gospel.
