Ephesians 3:1–6 (ESV) — For this reason I, Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles— assuming that you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was given to me for you, how the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as I have written briefly. When you read this, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit. This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.

Ephesians 2:6 (NLT) — For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 4:1 (ESV) — I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called,

Ephesians 6:13 (ESV) — Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm.

Our Rescue is the Focus of God's Plan

Ephesians 3:4–5 (ESV) — When you read this, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit.

Ephesians 1:4 (NLT) — Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes.

Ephesians 1:9–10 (ESV) — Making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

Every story worth remembering becomes a kind of signpost pointing us to the greater Story God is telling, the story of redemption in Christ.



Ephesians 3:10 (ESV)

So that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.

1. To the Angels of God

1 Peter 1:10-12 (ESV)

Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully, inquiring what person or time the Spirit of Christ in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories.
