Revelation 12:11 (ESV) — And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death.

John 19:30 (ESV) — When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, "It is finished," and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Revelation 12:7–8 (ESV) — Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back, but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven.

Revelation 12:9–10 (ESV) — And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. And I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ have come, for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God.

John 12:31–32 (ESV) — Now is the judgment of this world; now will the ruler of this world be cast out. And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself."

Ephesians 1:19–22 (NLT) — I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him. This is the same mighty power that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms. Now he is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else—not only in this world but also in the world to come. God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made him head over all things for the benefit of the church.

Ephesians 2:6 (NLT) — For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.

Revelation 12:12 (ESV) — Therefore, rejoice, O heavens and you who dwell in them! But woe to you, O earth and sea, for the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!"

1. <u>SURRENDER</u> daily to the <u>WILL</u> of God

Revelation 12:11a (ESV) — And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb ...

Luke 22:41–42 (NLT) — He walked away, about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, "Father, if you are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine."

The path of Christ's victory travels through the valleys of Christ's difficulties

Romans 12:1–2 (ESV) — I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

2. <u>LIVE</u> daily by the <u>WORD</u> of God

Revelation 12:11b (ESV) — And they have conquered him ... by the word of their testimony ...

2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV) — Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

Psalm 119:105 (NLT) — Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path.

Psalm 119:11 (NLT) — I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

Revelation 2:7a (ESV) — He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Isaiah 30:21 (ESV) — And your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it," when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left.

3. <u>FOLLOW</u> daily in your <u>WALK</u> with God

Revelation 12:11 (ESV) — And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for <u>they loved not their lives even unto death</u>.

Ephesians 2:10 (ESV) — For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Galatians 5:16–17 (NLT) — So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions.

1 Corinthians 11:26 (ESV) For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

1 Peter 2:24 (NLT)

1 John 1:9 (ESV) — If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Romans 8:39 (NLT)

No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 8:36 (ESV) So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

Colossians 1:13 (NLT) — For he has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of his dear Son

Isaiah 53:3 (ESV)

He was despised and rejected by men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

Matthew 8:17 (NIV)

This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities and bore our diseases."

1 Corinthians 11:23–24 (ESV)

For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

1 Corinthians 11:25 (ESV) — In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."
