There is a REALITY beyond the veil of our UNDERSTANDING that Jesus came to UNVEIL!

1. SEARCH for the SOURCE of life beyond the veil

John 6:1–2 (ESV) — After this Jesus went away to the other side of the Sea of Galilee, which is the Sea of Tiberias. And a large crowd was following him, because they saw the signs that he was doing on the sick.

John 6:24 (ESV) — So when the crowd saw that Jesus was not there, nor his disciples, they themselves got into the boats and went to Capernaum, seeking Jesus.

Mark 6:34 (ESV) — When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. And he began to teach them many things.

2. SERVE others the SUPPLY of life beyond the veil

John 6:5b–7 (ESV) — ... Jesus said to Philip, “Where are we to buy bread, so that these people may eat?” He said this to test him, for he himself knew what he would do. Philip answered him, “Two hundred denarii worth of bread would not be enough for each of them to get a little.”

John 6:8–9 (ESV) — One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, said to him, “There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish, but what are they for so many?”

3. SURRENDER to the SUSTENANCE of life beyond the veil

John 6:26–27 (ESV) — “Truly, truly, I say to you, you are seeking me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves. Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal.”
