Time, Talent, & Treasure

Acts 2:41 (ESV), "So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls."

Acts 2:42 (ESV), "And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers."

1. Devoted believers know God's Word

Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV), "And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'"

2. Devoted believers remain in fellowship

Acts 2:46 (ESV), "And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts..."

Hebrews 10:24-25 (ESV), "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near."
