Stewardship

Matthew 6:33 (ESV)

But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Luke 11:2-3 (ESV)

² And he said to them, “When you pray, say:...³ Give us each day our daily bread...”

STEWARDSHIP

Prayerful stewardship acknowledges that our God has given us everything we have, inviting His wisdom in managing what we've received, and presents our needs to Him every day.

3 Ways to be prayerful through the approach of Stewardship:

- **THANK HIM FOR EVERYTHING**

James 1:17 (ESV)

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

1 Corinthians 4:7 (ESV)

For who sees anything different in you? What do you have that you did not receive? If then you received it, why do you boast as if you did not receive it?

3 Ways to be prayerful through the approach of Stewardship:

- **THANK HIM FOR EVERYTHING**
- **HELP ME TO MANAGE ALL THINGS**

Luke 16:10 (ESV)

One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much.

Proverbs 3:9-10 (ESV)

Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; ¹⁰ then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.

3 Ways to be prayerful through Stewardship:

- **THANK HIM FOR EVERYTHING**
- **HELP ME TO MANAGE ALL THINGS**
- **ASK HIM SPECIFICALLY FOR SOMETHING**

Philippians 4:6-7 (NLT)

⁶ Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank him for all he has done. ⁷ Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

Acts 17:25b (NLT)
