John 2:1–3 (ESV) — On the third day there was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus also was invited to the wedding with his disciples. When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to him, “They have no wine.”

1. Only Jesus *SATISFIES* our deepest longings

John 14:27 (ESV) — Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.

John 3:29 (ESV) — The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the bridegroom’s voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete.

2 Corinthians 11:2 (ESV) — For I feel a divine jealousy for you, since I betrothed you to one husband, to present you as a pure virgin to Christ.

John 2:3–4 (ESV) — When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to him, “They have no wine.” And Jesus said to her, “Woman, what does this have to do with me? My hour has not yet come.”

John 2:4a (ESV) — ...“Woman, what does this have to do with me? ...”

John 2:4b (ESV) — “... My hour has not yet come.”

John 7:30 (ESV) — So they were seeking to arrest him, but no one laid a hand on him, because his hour had not yet come.

John 8:20 (ESV) — These words he spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple; but no one arrested him, because his hour had not yet come.

John 12:27–28a (ESV) — “Now is my soul troubled. And what shall I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour’? But for this purpose I have come to this hour. Father, glorify your name.”

John 12:23–24 (ESV) — And Jesus answered them, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.”

2. Only Jesus PURIFIES our messed up lives

John 6:53 (ESV) — So Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you.

John 6:28–29 (ESV) — Then they said to him, “What must we do, to be doing the works of God?” Jesus answered them, “This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent.”

1 John 1:7–9 (ESV) — But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. 8 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

John 2:8–11 (ESV) — And he said to them, “Now draw some out and take it to the master of the feast.” So they took it. When the master of the feast tasted the water now become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom and said to him, “Everyone serves the good wine first, and when people have drunk

freely, then the poor wine. But you have kept the good wine until now.”

3. Only Jesus QUALIFIES our readiness for heaven’s wedding!

Luke 14:23 (ESV) — And the master said to the servant, ‘Go out to the highways and hedges and compel people to come in, that my house may be filled.

Revelation 7:13–14 (ESV) — Then one of the elders addressed me, saying, “Who are these, clothed in white robes, and from where have they come?” I said to him, “Sir, you know.” And he said to me, “These are the ones coming out of the great tribulation. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
