Romans 6:6-13

1. Let go of what spiritual freedom CANCELS

Romans 6:6-7 (ESV)

⁶ We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. ⁷ For one who has died has been set free from sin.

Galatians 2:20 (ESV)

I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

a) We are free from the STAIN of sin

b) We are free from the REIGN of sin

Romans 6:12 (ESV)

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions.

Romans 6:14 (ESV)

For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

2. Remember what spiritual freedom COSTS

Exodus 6:6 (ESV)

Say therefore to the people of Israel, 'I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from slavery to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment.'

Exodus 12:13 (ESV)

The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you, when I strike the land of Egypt.

Romans 6:8-10 (ESV)

⁸ Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹ We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. ¹⁰ For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God.

Revelation 1:5 (ESV)

⁵ ...and from Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood...

3. Move into what spiritual freedom CREATES

Romans 6:11-13 (ESV)

¹¹ So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. ¹² Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. ¹³ Do not present your members to sin as instruments for

unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.

a) To be alive means to have ACCESS to His PRESENCE

b) To be alive means to have the ABILITY to be PRESENTABLE

Romans 6:13 (ESV)

Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.
