**1. Submission to authority pleases God**

**Romans 13:1-2;5 (NLT), "Everyone must submit to governing authorities. For all authority comes from God, and those in positions of authority have been placed there by God. <sup>2</sup> So anyone who rebels against authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and they will be punished." <sup>5</sup> So you must submit to them, not only to avoid punishment, but also to keep a clear conscience."**

**2. Submission to authority displeases our enemy**

**Romans 6:17-18 (ESV), "But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, <sup>18</sup> and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness."**

**3. Submission to authority teaches and trains us for more of God**

**Philippians 2:5-8 (ESV) "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."**
