- 3. Day 10 emphasizes sharing the gospel "in the power of the Holy Spirit." What does this mean to you, and how can we rely more on the Holy Spirit in our evangelism efforts?
- 4. Pastor Kyle set a goal of seeing 3,000 people saved and baptized by 2033. How does setting such a bold goal impact our faith and actions? Do you find it inspiring or daunting?
- 5. What are some practical ways we can reach out to "Far From God People" in our community?
- 6. How can we cultivate a sense of urgency for evangelism in our own lives and in our church?

## **Practical Applications:**

- 1. Personal Evangelism Challenge: This week, pray for an opportunity to share your faith with someone who is far from God.
- 2. Prayer Partners: Pair up with someone to pray regularly for the salvation of specific individuals in your lives.
- 3. Identify Local Outreach Opportunities: Research potential outreach activities in your community that could help reach those far from God.
- 4. Develop a Prayer Strategy: Create a plan to pray consistently for church growth and for those who don't know Christ.
- 5. Invite and Invest: Commit to inviting one person to church or a church event in the next month, and to invest in building a relationship with them.
