

The Blood Still Works

Leviticus 17:11

“For the life of the flesh is in the blood...”

The blood of Jesus is not only about the price that was paid—it is about the life that was given. The same blood that saved us is still working today.

1. The Blood Communicates

Genesis 4:8–12

After Cain killed Abel, God said that Abel’s blood was crying out from the ground.

Blood has a voice. Abel’s blood cried out because something was unfinished, broken, and out of order.

Hebrews 12:24

The blood of Jesus speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

Where Abel’s blood cried out for justice, the blood of Jesus speaks grace, mercy, forgiveness, and redemption.

When the enemy brings accusation, Jesus stands as our advocate and His blood testifies on our behalf.

2. The Blood Covers

Exodus 12

At Passover, the blood of the lamb marked the homes of Israel. The blood showed that the house belonged to God and was under His protection.

Exodus 24

The people personally entered into covenant with God, and Moses sprinkled them with the blood of the covenant.

It is not enough to only be around people who are covered by the blood. Every person must make their own decision to enter covenant with God.

Mark 14:24

Jesus said, “This is my blood of the covenant...”

The old covenant placed blood on the outside, but through Jesus, the new covenant changes us from the inside.

3. The Blood Cleanses

Leviticus 16

On the Day of Atonement, the high priest applied blood beginning in the Holy of Holies and worked outward.

God does not ask us to fix everything on the outside before coming to Him. He begins in the hidden places of the heart.

When God transforms the heart, He renews the mind, changes our desires, and impacts the way we live.

We could not do it ourselves, so Jesus did it for us.

4. The Blood Conquers

Revelation 12:11

“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony...”

The blood of Jesus conquered sin, shame, guilt, death, and the grave.

The blood does not just represent a past victory—the blood continues to work.

There is still power in the blood of Jesus.
