

## YOUR HAIR IS GONNA GROW BACK

(Judges 16:21-30)

### BIG IDEA:

Even after failure, compromise, and loss... God is not finished with you.

Your hair is gonna grow back.

### 1. THE CONTEXT: A LIFE OF CYCLES

- Serve God → Sin → Oppression → Cry Out → Deliverance → Repeat
- Samson is not just a story... he is a mirror

### 2. GOD USES COMPLICATED PEOPLE

- Abraham, Moses, David: anointed but flawed
- God is not looking for perfect people, but available people

### 3. CALLED TO SHINE — BUT LIVING IN SHADOWS

- Samson = “like the sun”
- Called to shine, but lived in compromise

### 4. CONSECRATION > POWER

- Nazarite vow
- Hair = outward sign of inward consecration
- It wasn't the hair... it was the holiness behind the hair

### 5. MISMANAGED CALLING

- You don't own the anointing—you manage it
- Some people don't lose their calling, they mismanage it

#### 6. WRONG PLACES CREATE UNNECESSARY BATTLES

- Some battles you wouldn't have if you weren't in places you don't belong

#### 7. COMPROMISE IS A SLOW EROSION

- Doesn't destroy overnight—erodes over time
- The enemy is after your identity

#### 8. USED BY GOD ≠ WALKING WITH GOD

- Don't just be used—be known

#### 9. THE BREAKING POINT: IDENTITY SURRENDERED

- God didn't leave when Samson struggled
- He left when Samson surrendered his identity

#### 10. THE TURNING POINT: "HOWEVER"

- In spite of everything... God is still working

#### 11. HOW RESTORATION WORKS

- Natural, silent, gradual
- Your failure was loud, but your restoration is quiet

#### 12. PRIVATE RESTORATION PRECEDES PUBLIC POWER

### 13. FINAL MOMENT

- "God, strengthen me one more time"
- Accomplished more in death than life

### APPLICATION:

- Break cycles
- Rebuild strength
- Embrace your "however" moment
