Protection through my good God

1. COVID, war, recession, politics, and sliding moral values are a sampling of the ways we get overwhelmed in the present and anxious for the future. If you are a believer in Jesus Christ then Ps 16:8 can ring true for you. What causes us not to believe or live as if we don't believe the words from David?

2. The Old Testament gives us the personal name of the Lord, Yahweh, and it is used four times in Ps 16. David's relationship to his God was not distant or impersonal, but one that was very close, intimate, and fulfilling. Does this describe your relationship to God? How can you cultivate growing it?

3. Friendships are an important part of life, and it is not surprising that scripture speaks to this dynamic repeatedly. David was attracted to the saints in Ps 16:3. Consider who your closest friends are and try to determine what makes them close. How does your reasoning line up with Psalm 1?



4. Satan is trying to fill this world with lies and deceptions to get you to believe in any other form of a god than the One True and Living God. How is a Christian able to determine false gods?

5. After all that God does for His people it is no wonder that He is Jealous for their affection. When we spend our time, express our delights, and find our comfort in things other than God would it translate to bringing wrath upon us? Why or why not?
