 - 1. Yahweh confirms his covenant with Noah in v. 18. Discuss the significance. What is a covenant? How does a covenant function between God and his people? How does your obedience relate to being in a covenantal relationship with God? What is the significance of the new covenant in regards to our salvation?

2. Noah is an example of faith (c.f., Hebrews 11:7). How does Noah's example of faith encourage, correct, or inform you? Noah's obedience was an expression of faith. How are faith and obedience related?

3. When we use the concrete language of obedience and disobedience regarding God's commands, it clarifies our obligation and moral responsibility. How does this clarity impact our pursuit of holiness? Discuss ways that we soften our obligation to God.

4. The text emphasizes Noah's obedience was comprehensive and complete (v. 22 "all... he did"). How is it that Noah didn't get saturated with worldly things? Where do you need to obey? How does the connection between faith and obedience help you identify how to grow in obedience?
