

SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE: FEBRUARY 8, 2026

WAIT FOR THE LORD – 2 CHRONICLES 20

1. Discussion Starter

- Let's be honest: When stress shows up, what do you reach for first: prayer, a plan, a person... or your phone? 😊

2. Wait for God's Answer (v.13)

- Place yourself for a moment in the sandals of one standing around the temple in prayer, and then waiting for God to answer even as a foreign army is ready to invade.
 - What are you feeling?
 - Is it hard to wait?
 - Are you scared?

3. The Battle is the Lord's (v.15)

- Can you share a time when the problem in front of you felt impossible but looking back you realize God was actually fighting it for you? How did that affect your trust in Him?

4. Trust and Obey (vv.16-20)

- Why do you think God involves His people at all if He doesn't need them to win?
- What does obedience accomplish in us, even when it doesn't seem necessary for the outcome?

5. Live Like God has Already Won (v.21-22)

- Why do you think God chooses praise rather than military strategy as the turning point of the story?
- Waiting on God (or not), reveals a lot about who we believe God is. If this is true, then what do your habits under pressure reveal about your confidence in God?
