

SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE: MARCH 8, 2026

LIFE WITH GOD AT THE CENTER – NUMBERS 7-8

1. Discussion Starter

- If you had to give up one of these for a month, which would be hardest: **Coffee/Tea, your phone, daily alone time?**

2. Seeing the Center (7:89)

- Imagine if God were visibly present in your community and speaking out loud from the center of it, how would that affect the way you live your daily life?
- Is God visibly present in our community? Does He still speak?

3. Responding with our Gifts (7:1-88)

- Why do you think God chose to record each tribe's gift individually instead of simply saying they all brought the same thing? How might this encourage us in the giving of our resources, the use of our gifts, and our service to God?

4. God Provide a way to Him (Chapter 8)

- The Levites were tasked with guarding God's presence so that His people could approach Him safely without being destroyed. Some think the God of the Old Testament was harsh and strict, and that the God of the New Testament is more gracious. Has God changed? If not, what has?
- How should a reverent view of God's holiness, affect our witness to the world around us?

- Is there anything in your life that needs to be brought into orbit around God at the center and submitted to His will that we can pray for together?
