

SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE: APRIL 12, 2026

FAITHFUL GOD TO SINFUL PEOPLE – NUMBERS 15

1. Discussion Starter

- What's a time you were convinced, "Okay, this is not going to go well," and then it surprisingly did?

2. God Remains Faithful to His Promise (vv. 2, 18)

- After 4 consecutive chapters filled with rebellion, God still speaks of the day when Israel will enter the land. What does this reveal to us about what God is really like?

3. God Provides Atonement for our Sin (vv. 25, 28)

- Forgiveness is declared after a costly, bloody sacrifice is made. Why does forgiveness only ever come after something so costly?
- Do you think we commonly minimize the seriousness of sin? Why?

4. God Warns against Presumption (vv. 30-37)

- There's a kind of sin in this passage described as "acting defiantly"; a settled posture of resisting God rather than repenting of our sin. What do you think this looks like, practically?
- Is there a difference between defiance and struggling against sin?

5. God Calls us to Remember

- God gives Israel tassels on their garments as a daily, physical reminder not to forget Him and drift into sin. What are some simple things that help you remember God in the middle your week?

6. Our Hope is in God's Faithfulness

- Across this chapter we see God's faithfulness, His provision for atonement, His warning against presumption, and His call to remember Him. What truth from this most encourages or challenges you today?
