In The Beginning(s): God

DISCUSSION STARTER:

 Think back to a time when you were filled with awe. Like when standing at the edge of the Grand Canyon, under a vast sky, or holding a newborn child. When is a moment you were in Awe?

Text

Read: Genesis 1:1-2, John 1:1-3, 14, and Jeremiah 9:23-24

DISCUSSION

1. In the Beginning: God

• The Bible begins, not with a proof or defense of God's existence, but rather with a simple declaration. Why do you think the Bible begins this way? And how do you think that instructs and shapes how we approach our faith and life?

2. God is Knowable yet Incomprehensible

- What helps you grow in knowing God personally?
- What reminds you that He is still far greater than you can imagine?

3. God is Not Like us

- God never changes. He is infinite, perfect, and completely independent. Is this Good News for us? How?
- How is God's perfect unity and eternal love within Himself as Father, Son and Spirit important for us to understand today?

4. God is the One who Comes Near

From creation to the cross to the coming kingdom, we see a God who pursues His people.
What difference does it make to you that the eternal, all-powerful God wants to be known and dwells with His people?
