Scripture Cross References (NKJV)

Resurrection Sunday

1 Corinthians 4:1: *Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.*

1 Corinthians 15:3-4: *For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures*

Luke 23:33: *And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left*

Mark 15:34: *My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me*

Mark 15:37-38: *And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last. Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom*

1 Corinthians 5:7: *For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us*

1 Peter 3:18: *For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God*

John 1:29: *Behold The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world*

2 Corinthians 5:21: *For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him*

Mark 16:9: *Now when He rose early on the first day of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven demons*

Matthew 28:9: *So they came and held Him by the feet and worshiped Him*

John 14:5-6: *Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way? Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me*

John 13:38: *Most assuredly, I say to you, the rooster shall not crow till you have denied Me three times*

John 21:17: *Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You. Jesus said to him, Feed My sheep*

John 14:23-24: *If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word*

John 14:15: *If you love Me, keep My commandments*

Acts 9:3-6: *Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me? I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. Lord, what do You want me to do*

Acts 26:18: *To open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me*

Luke 24:46-48: *It was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. And you are witnesses of these things*

Luke 24:52: *And they worshiped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy*
