Isaiah 61 - 62

Matthew 1:20: "...for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit."

Luke 3:22: "And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him..."

Yet, if you warn the wicked, and he does not turn from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered your soul."
