Theme: The Way

1. God's Offer: Isaiah 65:1-7

- *God reveals Himself to those not seeking Him*
- *Gentiles receive what Israel largely rejects*
- *God calls a rebellious people who follow their own ways*
- *Persistent sin exposed: idolatry, false worship, spiritual pride*
- *Ancestry cannot save*
- *There is only one way to God*

2. A Remnant Saved: Isaiah 65:8-12

- *God preserves a believing remnant*
- *His elect and servants inherit His promises*
- *Salvation comes by grace through faith in the Redeemer*
- *Those who seek the Lord are restored*
- *Discipline becomes a doorway to hope*
- *Each person must choose which group to belong to*

3. Servants and Enemies: Isaiah 65:13-16

- *Two completely different outcomes*
- *God's servants rejoice and are satisfied*
- *Rejecters experience loss and shame*
- *God's people receive a new identity belonging to Him*
- *Forgiven sin is remembered no more*

4. All Things New: Isaiah 65:17-25

- *God creates a new heaven and a new earth*
- *Joy replaces sorrow*
- *The redeemed dwell with God forever*
- *Eternal life for those who believe in the Son*
- *Creation restored under Christ's reign*
- *God is near and answers before His people call*

Scripture Cross References

Isaiah 65

Romans 11:5: *Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace.*

John 1:12: *But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name.*

Romans 10:9 to 13: *If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.*

Colossians 1:16: *All things were created through Him and for Him.*

Hebrews 8:12: *For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.*

Romans 11:26 to 27: *And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; For this is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins.*

John 6:40: *And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day.*

2 Corinthians 5:17: *Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.*
