Theme: Who Truly Belongs to the Lord

- *Whose Are His - Isaiah 66:1-4*
 - *God contrasts His greatness with human religion*
 - *He regards the humble and contrite*
 - *False worship mixes devotion with delight in sin*
 - *Refusal to return leads to delusion*
- *The Righteous Rewarded - Isaiah 66:5-9*
 - *True believers may be rejected by the religious*
 - *God promises vindication*
 - *A final separation is coming*
 - *The faithful enter His kingdom*
- *Maranatha - Isaiah 66:7-14*
 - *Zion is restored*
 - *A nation is spiritually reborn*
 - *Salvation comes suddenly*
 - *God comforts and revives His people*
- *Final Warning - Isaiah 66:15-24*
 - *God comes in judgment*
 - *False cleansing cannot save*
 - *All hearts will be revealed*
 - *The righteous worship*
 - *The rebellious are judged*

Isaiah 66

Ezekiel 23:39: *For after they had slain their children for their idols, on the same day they came into My sanctuary to profane it and indeed thus they have done in the midst of My house*

1 John 1:9: *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness*

2 Thessalonians 2:11: *And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie*

Zechariah 12:9-10: *It shall be in that day that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem and I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication. Then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.*

Revelation 19:15: *Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations*

Mark 9:45-46: *To be cast into hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched where their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched*

1 Timothy 2:4: *Who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth*
