***Theme: Don't Outsource Judgment***

***1. Keep It in House - 1 Corinthians 6:1-3***

- ***Resolve disputes among believers***
- ***Do not seek justice from the unrighteous***
- ***Remember your future role in judgment***

***2. Judge Well - 1 Corinthians 6:4-6***

- ***The church has the Spirit and wisdom***
- ***Handle matters with discernment***
- ***Public lawsuits damage the witness***

***3. Suffering Wrong Is Sometimes Right - 1 Corinthians 6:7-8***

- ***Lawsuits reveal spiritual failure***
- ***Better to be wronged than to retaliate***
- ***Vengeance belongs to God***

***4. Die To The Old - 1 Corinthians 6:9-11***

- ***Unrighteous living marks the unsaved***
- ***Sin patterns reveal identity***
- ***Believers are washed, sanctified, justified***

**1 Corinthians 5:12-13:** *“For what have I to do with judging those also who are outside? Do you not judge those who are inside? But those who are outside God judges. Therefore ‘put away from yourselves the evil person.’”*
