

Eight Marks of a Bond Servant of Christ

Deuteronomy 15:12-17

How Hebrews Became Bond Servants

1. **Poverty:** A Hebrew could voluntarily sell themselves for service to another. (Exod. 21:2; Lev. 25:39)
2. **Theft:** A Hebrew could be sold to make restitution for a theft. (Ex. 22:3)
3. **Birth:** Those born to bond servants were born into servitude as a condition of their birth. (Ex. 21:4)
4. **Debt:** Debtors might be sold, by creditors, as a condition of their debt. (Lev. 25:39,47)
