- 1. Something extraordinary happened on or about April 5, 33 A.D.
- 2. This is the jurisdiction of the historical method, not the scientific method.

- 5. This written testimony contains "embarrassing" elements that argue for its veracity.
- 6. Hostile sources corroborate the central claims of the written testimony.
