For Christ's Sake: Trusting God in the Calm and Crisis "How Jehoiachin Raised the Expectations of Palm Sunday"

2 Kings 25:27–28; Jeremiah 22-23; John 12:9–15 The Lord's Day Morning | Palm Sunday March 24, 2024

We've seen in our study of 1 and 2 Kings, that the author leaves out details that are provided by other Biblical authors. This morning's text gets a huge assist from Jeremiah's prophecy in Jeremiah 22–23, which he made concerning King Jehoiachin. When you put it all together, you'll have a greater understanding of the significance of Palm Sunday.
