Reason 3: The Joy of God's Glory Philippians 1:8–11 The Lord's Day Morning November 17, 2019

- Q1: What is the glory of God?
- A1: The glory of God is his eternal and brilliant perfection in all of his attributes and actions.
- Q2: What does it mean to "glorify God," or "give God glory"?
- A2: To glorify God is to think, say, and do those things which re-direct the world's attention to the one, true, and living God—from creation to the Creator. To make Jesus famous.
- Q3: What is the connection between our joy and God's glory?
- A3: When we glorify God, we are doing exactly what we were designed and made to do and that is when we are the happiest.
- Q4: What does Paul ask God to do for the Philippians that will result in their joy for God's glory?
- A4: Paul asks God to empower them to do three things:
