For Christ's Sake: Trusting God in the Calm and Crisis Is This the One?

2 Kings 24:1–25:7
The Lord's Day Morning
March 3, 2024

In Josiah's reign we were reminded how God promised to make Israel a great nation, forgiving their sins, and guiding them through the Book. When the Book is rediscovered and the covenant renewed, they took the Book from Jerusalem, to Judea, and Samaria, replacing idolatry with the worship of the true God and foreshadowing Acts 1:8. In the Book, God promises to provide a descendant of Eve who is also a son of David to save them (Gen. 3:15; 2 Sam. 7). Each generation asked, Is this the One? This morning's text offers four more failed candidates.

1. Jehoahaz, the	King who is taking the

3. Jehoiachin, the _ proud	King who is taken by (24:8–17).
4. Zedekiah, the	King who is tried and (24:18–25:7).
