Throughout 1 Thessalonians we are called to be people of character, especially to those outside the household of faith. In 1 Thessalonians Paul demonstrates two essential traits necessary for effective, credible leadership:

Competence + Character = Credibility

Competence: The ability to articulate and defend sound doctrine in love.

Character: The humility to apply and practice sound doctrine in love.

Credibility: The quality of being trustworthy, reliable, convincing, and believable.

This credibility with those outside the church requires hard work. Indeed, in order to be a credible witness to others, we must work to proclaim the gospel in word and deed, until Christ returns.
