

# How to be a witness for Jesus in one-off encounters with people

Write a list of as many people as you can remember that you have had **one-off** conversations with in the last month. If you can remember, write beside each person the **topic** of conversation.

1. Have your \_\_\_\_\_ up (vv. 1-7)
2. Take the first \_\_\_\_\_ step (vv. 7-9)
3. Say something that \_\_\_\_\_ the conversation to go deeper and see what happens (vv. 10-15)
4. Don't avoid the topic of \_\_\_\_\_ and getting right with God (vv. 16-18)

5. As you talk, ask God to \_\_\_\_\_ you (vv. 17-18)
  
6. Allow the other person to help \_\_\_\_\_ the conversation (v. 20)
  
7. If you sense this person is open and spiritually hungry, head straight for the \_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 19-26)
  
8. Recognize that people all around you are \_\_\_\_\_ to have these conversations (vv. 28-35)
