4. To change _____. He conquers by the Word, not the sword (Jn. 18:36; Heb. 4:12)
5. To affirm _____. He is David's Lord (Luke 20:41-42).
6. To confirm _____. He must be obeyed (Luke 1:30-33; John 3:36).
7. To remove _____. He suffered in the place of sinners (2 Samuel 7:14; Isa. 53:6).
