Review for Parents

- 1. Thesis: The best way to help your children lay the foundation for their future happiness is to rightly understand and properly obey the Ten Commandments.
- 2. The convicting use of the Law: *Before* we are saved, the Ten Commandments help us diagnose our guilt and feel our need for a Savior, leading us to the cure of the cross.
- 3. Principle: The good news will never be good to us unless the bad news is very real to us.
- 4. The teaching use of the Law: *After* we are saved, the Ten Commandments help us know how to please God for our happiness and his glory.
- 5. Principle: God does not love us because we keep the Ten Commandments proficiently. We keep the Ten Commandments because God loves us unconditionally.
- 6. Principle: The Ten Commandments have never been, and can never be, a way to earn heaven.
