## "Therefore:" The Logical Lifestyle of a Hopeful Minority We Believe in the Son's Redemption

Ephesians 1:7–10 (Page 976 in Chair Bible) The Lord's Day Morning August 28, 2016

After affirming the Father's election (1:3–6), Paul focuses on the Son's redemption (1:7–10). Redemption refers to being set free from slavery as a result of a payment of a ransom. In Christ, God has turned slaves into sons! Here are three important facets to the redemption of the elect.
